

**Minutes of the 8<sup>th</sup> Licensing Committee Meeting (LCM-2025 series) held on 10.12.2025 at 10:00 AM (in hybrid mode) in Room No.225, Vanijya Bhawan.**

The 8<sup>th</sup> Licensing Committee Meeting (LCM-2025 series) was held on 10.12.2025 at 10:00 AM (in hybrid mode) at Vanijya Bhawan. The list of participants is Annexed.

2. At the outset, Joint Secretary, DPIIT & Member-Secretary of the Licensing Committee welcomed the participants and informed the Committee about the action taken with respect to the 11 proposals, 02 under Arms Act and 09 under IDR Act considered in the 7<sup>th</sup> LC Meeting (2025 series) held on 14.11.2025, wherein 09 proposals were recommended, 02 proposals were deferred. The Minutes of the same were issued on 03.12.2025 and it was also apprised to the house that 07 Industrial Licenses have been issued and fees has been sought from the applicants in 02 cases. Thereafter, Joint Secretary & Member-Secretary requested Secretary, DPIIT & Chairman of the License Committee for his remarks.

3. The Chair welcomed all the participants and reviewed the pendency of applications at various levels. The Chair reiterated the necessity of a reduced timeline for clearing applications. In this regard the following was decided:

(i) The portal will be migrated to NSWS, and all the Forms including DDP Annexure and MHA Security Proforma shall be made live on NSWS within this month. JS & Member Secretary stated that the Forms have been developed. The Chair advised all stakeholders to send their inputs, if any, pertaining to the forms immediately.

(ii) The Chair sought information from the States on the procedure followed for finalising their views/ comments on the proposal. Response from the states of Telangana, Haryana and Maharashtra indicated that different States have different procedures and different levels at which approvals are given. In some states, security clearance is sought from the State CID/Intelligence whereas in others it is not. This is in addition to the security assessment done at the Government of India level. The Chair directed the Joint Secretary to document the procedures followed by all states/UTs including the agencies of the state

that are consulted before sending their inputs comments, and devise common procedures. This should be presented to the LCM within a month.

(iii) The Central agencies were also advised to streamline their processes so that their views are available within two months without fail.

4. The Committee also reiterated its decision that General Principles decided by the Inter- Ministerial Committee (IMC) to decide on the additional inputs provided by MHA on security clearances and their comments in its meeting held on 24.04.2018 at NITI Aayog, New Delhi shall be applicable in all the cases considered by the Licensing Committee.

5. Thereafter, Joint Secretary & Member-Secretary apprised that 52 incomplete applications on the G2B portal wherein clarifications to the queries raised by DPIIT were pending from the applicant unit till 31.07.2025, and where a final notice had been given to the applicants, have been closed after due intimation to the applicants to apply afresh after attending to the deficiencies. The Chair was also apprised that FAQs have been uploaded on the G2B portal regarding automatic closure of non-responsive applications on 31<sup>st</sup> day and regarding the decision pertaining to time validity of land lease being replaced to valid land lease document at the time of application and approval.
